**842** Ω A 1858-59 **First Roulettes** 1d yellow-green SG 13 with rouletting on all sides, unused, Cat £1100. A very scarce stamp, that was absent from *Don Pearce's* collection. *RPSoIV Certificate* (2009). Note that, as with SG (5) & 6, *Gibbons* have now amalgamated SG 13 & 14 because the shades are essentially the same.

**843** \* A 1860-69 **Second Roulettes** 'TEN PENCE' in Blue on 9d orange-red SG 35, rouletting on all sides, large-part original gum, Cat £600.

847 Ω\* A/A- 1868-79 Perf 11½-12½ 1d deep yellow-green (rounded corner at upper-right, large-part original gum), '3-PENCE' on 4d ultramarine, 4d dull purple, 9d red-purple and 1/- bright red-brown, unused, Cat £830. (5) 250



Lot 848

848 F A - 'TEN PENCE' in Blue on 9d yellow SG 78a with the *Watermark Reversed*, GPO cds of NO11/68, Cat £2000. Absent from 'Besancon'. *Harry Lower's*, *Michael Blake's* and *Don Pearce's* examples sold for \$2990 \$2445 & \$2242 respectively.

**A rare stamp that is seriously underrated**, in part because it is listed by *Gibbons* under the *Large Star Watermark* issue., where it is "lost". **No unused examples have been recorded.** Often characterised as an 'error', in the catalogue for the *John Griffiths'* sale, it was noted that this was a trial printing on the paper to be used for the new *De La Rue* 2d SG 152, issued in August 1868. We consider that it was either that or an emergency printing perhaps inadvertently on the new paper, and expect that all examples have the watermark reversed. *Gary Diffen* has recorded about 40 examples, some of which are defective or 'dwarf' stamps.

850 \*V A 1876-1904 De La Rue Crown/SA Perf 13 1d as SG 175 in yellow-green with *Queen after a Date with Edward Scissor-Hands*, large-part original gum; and in blue-green with similar variety also with *Blindfolded Queen*, very lightly cancelled. Two remarkable and dramatic varieties. (2)

**851** G/F A - 1d scarlet Perf 13 SG 176a with *Major Cracked Electro* from Frame above First 'A' of 'AUSTRALIA' to Frame below 'N' of 'ONE', two examples with light squared-circle cancel largely clear of the crack or Adelaide cds that impinges more on the crack. Rare & unlisted in the ACSC: a less prominent crack ACSC S6d is priced at \$175. An extraordinary variety, the equal of the famous 'Big Crack' on the Kangaroo 1d. (2)

**854** \* A- **1902-04 Thin 'POSTAGE'** 1/- brown vertical pair from the base of the sheet *Imperforate Between & at the Base* ACSC S30Bbb (SG 275b), faint bend, lightly mounted, Cat \$2500 (£2750). *Ex Dr Don Pearce*. The ACSC states "Ten pairs exist; one is in the *Royal Collection*". Four of the pairs are in two blocks of 4. *Michael Blake's* pair - rough perfs & small hinge remainder - sold for \$2975. The '*Chartwell*' pair sold for £1560.

**855** \* B **1904-11 Thick 'POSTAGE'** 6d blue-green SG 284 marginal horizontal pair from the base of the sheet *Imperforate at Base* ACSC S42b, ironed-out horizontal crease, lightly mounted, Cat \$4000+, for singles. *Ex Ric Slade-Slade and Dr Don Pearce*. The ACSC states that **only a mint pair (and no used examples) has been recorded.**

**856** \* A+ - 9d brown-red SG 286 marginal horizontal pair from the top of the sheet *Imperforate at Top* ACSC S50b, very lightly mounted, Cat \$6000+, for two used singles; unpriced unused. **Superb**. *Ex Dr Don Pearce*. The ACSC records **only one used (and no unused) example**. *Gary Diffen's* mint **single** sold for £840.

**857** \*/\*\* A+ - 10d brown-orange SG 287 corner vertical pair from the lower-right of the sheet *Imperforate at Right*, the lower unit is unmounted. Unlisted in the ACSC. **Superb**. *Ex Dr Don Pearce*. *Gary Diffen's* mounted single - minor blemishes - sold for £455. *Gary Diffen* stated that **only three examples have been recorded**.

**858** \* A- - 10d brown-orange SG 287 marginal single from the left of the sheet *Imperforate at Left* S53bc with full sheet margin, tiny black mark on the face, Cat \$2000. *Ex Dr Don Pearce*. The ACSC states "...has been recorded but no details are available". *Gary Diffen* states that **five examples have been recorded**. His truncated example - trimmed just left of the jubilee line - sold for £420.

- 859** \* A - 10d brown-orange corner pair from the upper-right of the sheet *Imperforate Between* S53b (SG 287a) with *Value/Sheet Number '10d 000874' in Vermilion*, the right-hand margin detached & rejoined, ink notation in the side-margin, Cat \$2500+ (£3500+), for a pair with the Sheet Number. *Ex Friedrich Krichauff, 'Hamilton' and Ex Dr Don Pearce. Gary Diffen states that eight pairs and a block of 4 have been recorded, "although, unusually, this error is rarely offered at auction". His pair sold for £1920.*

- 860** \* A+ - 1/- brown marginal block of 4 from the left of the sheet comprising two vertical pairs *Imperforate Between Horizontally* S54ba (SG 288a), ink notation in the margin, very lightly mounted, Cat \$4000+ (£6000+), for two pairs. **Superb.** *Ex Friedrich Krichauff and Dr Don Pearce. Gary Diffen recorded eight pairs in private hands & stated "one is damaged and most exhibit slight imperfections". His pair sold for £1440.*

- 861** O A/B **1906-12 Thick 'POSTAGE' Crown/A Double Perforation Errors** comprising 3d at right with 'YORKETOWN' cds, 8d at right with 'PARCEL POST...' cds, 8d at base with boxed 'LATE FEE' handstamp (toned perfs), 1/- at right with Adelaide cds, and 2/6d at right - **unlisted** in the ACSC - with 'RUNDLE STREET' squared-circle (remarkably for a used item with *Official Repair* still in place), Cat \$950, plus the unlisted 2/6d. *Ex Dr Don Pearce. (5)*

**862** \* A- - Perf 12 6d blue-green SG 300 marginal horizontal pair from the base of the sheet *Imperforate between the Stamps & the Margin* ACSC S43b, faint horizontal bend, lightly mounted, Cat \$2000+, for singles. *Ex Dr Don Pearce*. Gary Diffen recorded four mint singles, four pairs & a strip of 4, several of which have faults. His **single** - "hinge remnants and tiny thin" - sold for £385. *Jeff Harris'* two **singles** sold for \$670 and \$725 respectively.

The ACSC states that two pairs, two blocks of 4 & a block of 8 (4x2) have been recorded. We have recorded the following results, all for **pairs**: *Ron Butler* for £1080; our auction of 24.5.2008 for \$2210; *Jeff Harris* for \$2095; and *Gary Diffen* for £1440.

- 9d dull lake marginal block of 4 from the base of the sheet *Imperforate Between Horizontally and at the Base* S52b (SG 302a var), a couple of light bends, Cat \$4000+ (£5000+), for two pairs. *Ex Dr Don Pearce*. *Gary Diffen's* similar **pair** from the upper pane - imperf between & above the gutter - sold for £1560. The ACSC entry combines the two variants. From the upper pane, two pairs have been recorded; from the lower pane, this block contains **the only recorded examples**.
