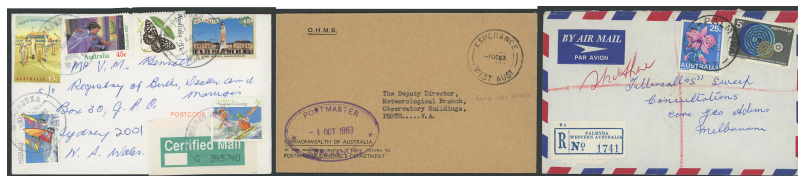
WESTERN AUSTRALIA - Datestamps & Other Town Markings

Virtually everything in this section is from the collection formed by Dr Andrew Johnston, hence the overwhelming number on his favourite KGV Heads. References in this section are to the indispensable 'Postal Markings Illustrated' (PMI) of the Western Australia Study Group (1984-1902). This monumental work has stood up very well to the test of time. One area, however, of ongoing ambiguity is the status of offices, especially in the mid-1920s. It has been established that the term 'Receiving Office' (RO) was not used officially (except by error in a couple of instances) after 1927. In fact, the available evidence points to all ROs in all States being designated as non-official Post Offices from 1 July 1927 (for further information see Volume One of 'The Post Offices & Hand-Held Datestamps of Victoria' by Watson Webster & Wood (1989) at pages 6-9). In PMI, many offices are noted as transitioning some time in 1927, and these entries can confidently be amended to 1.7.1927. In other cases, it is stated that an RO closed or was designated as a Telegraph Office (TO) at a later date. In every such case, we believe transition from RO to PO occurred on 1.7.1927. Note also that many of the smallest of these offices closed before 1930, presumably because the mail volumes were unsustainably low.



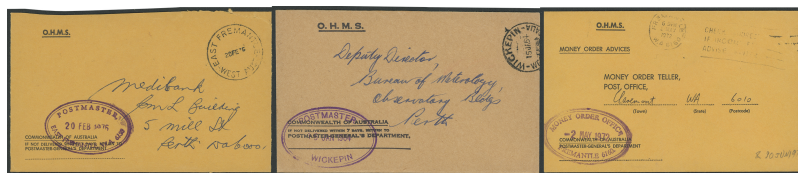
